Job Jots Loose Script

- Share your name, position, company information, and what you want students and job seekers to know about your business.
- Share some of the skills or aptitudes necessary to succeed in your business or industry (interacting with people, enjoying math, love for cars, helping people in crisis, etc.).
- Share what is necessary to gain employment or move upward in your field (high school diploma, GED, specific trainings, experiences, or certifications, etc.).
- Share why you enjoy working in your career field.
- End with "Thanks for watching this Job Jots video!"

Tip: If possible, show your work environment and where the action happens. This will help give a more accurate depiction of your day.
